Workshops with Oxford Asylum Welcome

Time for Art has been offering art workshops for 2 years to young people supported by Oxford Asylum Welcome. This charity offers support to unaccompanied children of different nationalities who are seeking asylum in the UK and escaping traumatic situations in their home countries. This year's art workshops have involved the young people enjoying portrait, cityscapes and abstract projects.

January 2023 onwards: Art workshops will continue on a monthly basis for young members of Oxford Asylum Welcome.

February 2023: A nature related art workshop will take place with children supported by the Kenyan charity Eden Thriving (www.edenthriving.org) in Naivasha, near Nairobi, Kenya. We will also continue to focus on further fundraising activities.
